### L'ÉDITION LIMITÉE – LIMITED EDITION

Cette gamme de vins en édition limitée est une ode à l'inventivité et à l'esprit de curiosité du Domaine Gayda. Inspirée de The Passenger, hymne pop-rock de l'icône Iggy Pop, elle affirme son caractère nomade avec un rouge et un blanc totalement éphémères, issus de parcelles, de terroirs, de cépages qui changeront à chaque année. En Passant revendique cet esprit vagabond sur ses étiquettes qui évoluent à la manière d'un story-board, au fil des millésimes.

*This limited edition range is designed as an ode to Domaine Gayda's spirit of creativity and inventiveness.*

*Inspired by The Passenger, the classic pop-rock anthem by Iggy Pop, its inherently restless character is expressed through a red and a white wine that are made from a different vineyard, terroir and grape variety each year, underscoring its ephemeral nature.*

*This 'rolling stone' concept is clearly mirrored in the labelling of En Passant with constantly changing imagery designed as a storyboard, through the vintages.*

Raisins d'altitude pressés lentement en grappes entières - très léger débourbage - vinification sans soufre à basse température - élevage sur lies.

*Grapes from altitude are pressed slowly in whole bunches - very gentle racking - vinification without sulphur, at low temperature - ageing on lees.*
