VILLA MON RÊVE

AOP Minervois La Livinière



The name 'Villa Mon Rêve' originates from the stone cottage built by the then vineyard owner for his convalescing wife. In this magical natural vineyard setting, she recovered, and the cottage was then named 'Villa Mon Rêve' or 'The House of My Dream'. The dream became viticultural when a block of old Syrah vines produced the wine that we had dreamt of – an elegant Syrah showcasing the ultimate in finesse and power.



LA PETITE VILLA

AOP Minervois La Livinière



A testament to the ancestral terroir of Minervois La Livinière. This blend of Syrah, Mourvèdre and Grenache highlights the characteristics of the appellation and the biodiversity of the terroir. Whilst respecting tradition, it is also in tune with the times. 'La Petite Villa' starts us off on the road to 'Villa Mon Rêve'.



REFLET

IGP Pays d'Oc



Never satisfied and always on the lookout for the quintessential expression of our terroirs, 'Reflet' was born from a selection of the best Grenache and Syrah. Unlike 'Chemin de Moscou', which is composed mainly of Syrah, then Grenache, 'Reflet' is resolutely Grenache-based.



CHEMIN DE MOSCOU

'Chemin de Moscou' is named after the 'Nom Cadastral' (land registry name) of the vineyards around our winery in the village of Brugairolles. Matured for 20 months in oak followed by a rigorous barrel selection, this blend of Syrah, Grenache and Cinsault is unquestionably the wine that defines Domaine Gayda.



ALTRE CAMÍ

'Altre Camí'...another path... another vision. This project was born of the desire to elevate our beautiful vineyards of the Roussillon. This trio of wines encapsulates the uniqueness and typicity of its Catalan terroirs.



LA MINUETTE

'La Minuette' blended rosé comes from La Livinière limestone terroir. A nod to both the past and the future, La Minuette represents the variety of rose planted in Kenya by co-founder Tim Ford in 1982, during his 25 years of rose production in Africa.



FIGURE LIBRE

'Figure Libre' epitomises the freedom to focus on grape varieties rarely grown in the Languedoc: Chenin Blanc and Cabernet Franc. In 2004 we planted the grape varieties which we felt would be best suited, those most able to reveal the expression and the qualities of our Brugairolles sandstone terroir.



FIGURE LIBRE FREESTYLE

'Figure Libre Freestyle' is the name given to an ambitious range of wines designed to shake up conventions and break new ground for expressing the inherent style of the Languedoc and Roussillon. Figure Libre Freestyle reflects a desire to think outside the box, favouring freedom of choice in terms of blends, as it brings together grape varieties that would never have otherwise met in the same bottle.



EN PASSANT

This range of wines is an ode to the inventiveness and curiosity of Domaine Gayda. Inspired by rock icon Iggy Pop's The Passenger, it expresses our nomadic spirit. Travelling with just a rucksack on our back, we are guided by the search for unusual terroirs, pausing for a moment to reflect on the creation of these unique blends... we're just passing through...



GAYDA-SPHÈRE

Our 'Gayda-Sphère' range captures the heart and soul of the diverse terroirs present throughout the Languedoc. From land and sea to hill and valley, the 'Gayda-Sphère' wines embrace both tradition and innovation to show the true essence of the grape varietal. Syrah, Grenache, Viognier, Chardonnay: these four single varietal wines will take you into the 'Gayda-Sphère'!



FLYING SOLO

The 'Flying Solo' range flies in the face of convention, shunning international varieties in favour of the typical Grenache grape which forms its backbone, blended with Syrah, Viognier and Cinsault respectively. It celebrates the intrepid Aéropostale pilots who risked life and limb to deliver postal services in the 1920s.

A New World spirit has been breathed into this range of single varietal wines that remain firmly rooted in their Languedoc homeland. Syrah and Sauvignon, the improbable confrontation of grape varieties and wine profiles, symbolise Domaine Gayda's origins and the fusion of two worlds, Old and New.
